Dr. Cheri Jimeno sees significant opportunity in work force and online course development in her role as President of New Mexico State University Alamogordo (NMSU-A). She became the President of NMSU-A in May 2007. During her tenure at the campus, enrollment has doubled, student retention has increased, and course and program assessment has become a campus norm. NMSU-A also increased its commitment to sustainability through implementation of a recycling program, LEED Gold certification for the Allied Health building, and installation of a solar-powered crosswalk.

Before coming to Alamogordo, Dr. Jimeno was the Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at Montana State University Northern in Havre. From 2001 until 2003, she served as Dean of the School of Education, Business and Technology at the University of Montana Western (UMW) in Dillon. From 1985 to 2001, she was a faculty member at UMW where she taught courses in business information systems, systems analysis and design, and strategic management.

Dr. Jimeno earned her Ph.D. in education and business information systems from Utah State University. She received her bachelor's degree in business administration from the University of Montana and her master's degree in business from Montana State University. Dr. Jimeno has received several honors and awards including a Fulbright Lectureship to the Bahamas.
